In an order entered on August 25, 2010, I granted plaintiff's request for pauper status on the condition that he prepay \$4.67 of the \$350 filing fee no later than September 15, 2010. Now plaintiff has filed a motion asking the court to extend the payment deadline because he was moved to another unit and he is waiting to receive his legal materials. Plaintiff's request is reasonable. Therefore, his motion will be granted.

In his motion for extension of time, plaintiff also mentions that he may need the court to appoint an attorney for him. Plaintiff explains that is unable to do his legal work because he suffers from schizophrenia, depression, severe anxiety and paranoia. For the court to consider such a request, plaintiff must file a motion to appoint an attorney. The motion must accompany at least three rejection letters from attorneys to show that plaintiff has made a reasonable effort to obtain an attorney. Plaintiff should be aware that the court, upon reviewing such a motion, must also consider the complexity of the case and the pro se plaintiff's ability to litigate the case himself.

As for plaintiff's request for a copy of the court's August 25, 2010 order and his August 26 letter request for the return of his original complaint filed on August 11, 2010, I am including those documents with this order as an enclosure.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff Terry Anderson's motion for an extension of time to pay the filing fee is GRANTED. He may have until September 30, 2010 to pay his \$4.67 initial partial payment on his \$350 filing fee.
