On November 11, 2010, I directed plaintiff Curtis Singleton to submit his six month trust fund account statement so that I could assess an initial partial payment of the \$350 fee for filing this case. Now, plaintiff has submitted a letter in which he asks about the status of his case. To date, the court has not received plaintiff's trust fund account statement. Although in his letter plaintiff does not ask the court for additional time to submit the statement, I will construe his letter as a motion for extension of time and extend the deadline for plaintiff to submit his trust fund account statement until December 22, 2010. Plaintiff's trust fund account statement should cover the six-month period beginning approximately April 30, 2010 and ending approximately October 31, 2010. Once plaintiff has submitted the necessary statement, I will calculate his initial partial payment and advise him of the amount he will have to pay before the court can screen the merits of his complaint under § 1915(e)(2).

If plaintiff fails to provide his statement, I will assume that he does not wish to proceed with this action and this case will be closed.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff is GRANTED an enlargement of time to December 22, 2010, in which to submit a trust fund account statement for the period beginning April 30, 2010 and ending approximately October 31, 2010. If, by December 22, 2010, plaintiff fails to respond to this order, I will assume that he wishes to withdraw this action voluntarily. In that case, the clerk of court is directed to close this file without prejudice to plaintiff's filing his case at a later date.
