On September 2, 2010, this court held the final pretrial conference. Defendant David Best waived his personal presence, but was represented by his attorney, Terry Frederick. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Steven Sinnott.

Prior to the hearing, the court circulated draft voir dire questions, jury instructions and a verdict form. The parties suggested minor changes to these documents, which the court accepted.

The parties had no *in limine* or housekeeping matters to bring to the court's attention. Not later than September 3, 2010, the parties are to telephone the clerk's office to report whether they wish to consent to have Magistrate Judge Crocker preside over the trial. In the event they consent to Judge Crocker, the September 9, 2010 final hearing is stricken as unnecessary. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention.
