On October 29, 2010, defendant José Aguilar-Huerta pled guilty to the petty offense of assault by beating, 18 U.S.C. § 113(a)(4). We proceeded directly to sentencing; after hearing from the defendant and the attorneys, the court imposed the following sentence:

It is ORDERED that defendant José Aguilar-Huerta is sentenced to the custody of the Bureau of Prisons for a term of 60 days, consecutive to any other sentence previously imposed upon Aguilar-Huerta.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that defendant José Aguilar-Huerta forthwith shall pay the $\$10^{00}$ special assessment to the clerk of this court.

This sentence serves the goals of general and specific deterrence, punishment of the defendant, and the protection of other Bureau of Prisons inmates.
