JUDGMENT AND  
COMMITMENT ORDER

10-cr-129-slc-2

On November 8, 2010, defendant Carlos Mejia pled guilty to the petty offense of assault by beating, 18 U.S.C. § 113(a)(4). We proceeded directly to sentencing; after hearing from the defendant and the attorneys, the court imposed the following sentence:

It is ORDERED that defendant Carlos Mejia is sentenced to the custody of the Bureau of Prisons for a term of 90 days, consecutive to any other sentence previously imposed upon Mejia.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that defendant Carlos Mejia forthwith shall pay the \$10<sup>00</sup> special assessment to the clerk of this court.

This sentence serves the goals of general and specific deterrence, punishment of the defendant, and the protection of other Bureau of Prisons inmates.
