ORDER

At a May 20, 2011 telephonic status conference, the parties, by counsel, reported that defendant currently is in Minnesota awaiting sentencing in state court following his conviction at a state criminal trial. The prosecutor in Minnesota will not commit to a date by which that state will return defendant to this court. Meanwhile, counsel for defendant in this court reports that the defense has not yet begun reviewing the computers requested from the government because the computers are in Milwaukee and because defendant has not been available to assist.

It is past time to get this case moving again. We will hold a status and scheduling conference in Courtroom 460 on June 22, 2011 at 10:30 a.m. Defendant must be present in person. Before that hearing, defendant's attorney shall perform whatever review of the computers is necessary to provide an accurate, objective report to the court about what the defense needs to do with the computers and how long it will take. Both sides shall be prepared to set a schedule leading to the earliest trial date that works for the parties, the witnesses and the court.
