On December 16, 2011, I denied without prejudice plaintiff Gregory Gorak's motion to modify the deadline for filing dispositive motions in this case. I advised plaintiff that as the dispositive motion deadline moves closer and he finds that he is unable to meet the deadline for reasons outside his control, he may renew his request for an extension. Now plaintiff has filed a motion to reconsider modification of the schedule in this case.

In his motion, plaintiff asks the court to modify the dispositive motion deadline to sometime in April 2012 and to adjust the trial date accordingly. Plaintiff states that he is still in the process of attempting to retrieve the legal materials that he was forced to leave behind after his December 2011 custody transfer from Wisconsin to the Elkton Federal

Correctional Institution in Lisbon, Ohio. Defendants have filed a response stating they do not oppose plaintiff's motion. In addition, defendants have filed with the court and provided to plaintiff the entire authenticated disciplinary record of plaintiff at issue in this case, consisting of 321 pages. Dkt. #35. Defendants further state that the procedural due process claim on which plaintiff is proceeding in this case will likely be resolved by dispositive motions. Accordingly, I will extend the deadline for filing dispositive motions in this case to March 8, 2012. The remaining schedule, including the July 16, 2012 trial date, will remain in place.

### ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff Gregory Sean Gorak's motion to reconsider modification of the schedule in this case, dkt. #33, is GRANTED in part. The new deadline for filing dispositive motions in this case is March 8, 2012.
