The parties have filed a stipulation for remand under sentence four of Section 405(g) of the Social Security Act. The motion will be granted.

On remand, plaintiff will be provided the opportunity for a hearing and to submit additional evidence and arguments. Additionally, on remand, the administrative law judge will: (1) reassess plaintiff's residual functional capacity; (2) if necessary, obtain supplemental evidence from a vocational expert; and (3) issue a new decision.
