ORDER

Plaintiff Yeng Cher Khang has filed a suit pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) for review of a final decision of the Commissioner of Social Security denying plaintiff's application for social security disability benefits. However, he has not paid the \$350 filing fee in this case. He has now submitted an affidavit of indigency as required by the court.

From this affidavit, I find that he is unable to prepay the fees and costs of commencing this action or to give security therefor. Therefore, her complaint and summons will be forwarded to the United States Marshal for service upon the defendant Michael Astrue.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff's request to proceed *in forma pauperis* is GRANTED and the United States Marshal shall serve the summons and complaint on defendant Michael Astrue.

The clerk of court is directed to forward the complaint, summons and marshal service forms to the United States Marshal.
