The Wisconsin Department of Justice has indicated that it will represent the defendants in this case. Pursuant to an agreement with this court, the Department will accept electronic service of documents on behalf of the defendants it represents. Therefore, for the remainder of this lawsuit, plaintiff does not have to send a paper copy of each document he files with the court to the Department. All he has to do is submit the document to this court, and the Department will access the document through the court's electronic filing system.

Discovery requests and responses are an exception to the electronic service rule. Usually, those documents should be sent directly to counsel for the opposing party and do not have to be sent to the court. Discovery procedures will be explained more fully at the preliminary pretrial conference.
