A telephone status conference was held in this case on September 22, 2014, before United States District Judge Barbara B. Crabb. Gregory Everts participated on behalf of plaintiff Doli Pulungan; Assistant United States Attorneys Meredith Duchemin and Leslie Herje participated on behalf of the United States.

Mr. Everts informed the court that plaintiff's visa has been denied, preventing Mr. Pulungan from appearing in person at the October 2, 2014 hearing. After discussing the specifics of the difficulties involved in plaintiff's inability to obtain a visa, the parties agreed that the only viable option would be for counsel to travel to Indonesia to take plaintiff's video deposition for use at a hearing at a later date. Counsel informed the court that it will take approximately three weeks for them to secure the necessary passports and clearance to travel to Indonesia for the purpose of obtaining a video deposition of plaintiff to be offered at a hearing in lieu of plaintiff's personal appearance.

In light of these new developments, the hearing set for October 2, 2014 will be rescheduled to December 10, 2014, beginning at 9:00 a.m. The video deposition will be introduced as evidence at the hearing. Any difficulties that arise as to the presentation of

plaintiff's rebuttal testimony will be resolved at the time of the hearing. Counsel believe that the hearing will last one day.
