ORDER

In an order entered on March 26, 2012, plaintiff was granted leave to proceed against defendants Pollard, Ericksen, Swiekatowski, Campbell, Raemisch and Delvaux in this case. On April 9, 2012, plaintiff filed a notice of appeal of that order. On April 16, this court denied plaintiff's request for leave to proceed in forma pauperis. Plaintiff was directed to pay the entire \$455 filing fee. Now before the court is plaintiff's motion for extension of time to pay the balance of his appeal filing fee and request for clarification.

In his motion, plaintiff asks for an extension of time to pay his appeal filing fee. He also asks for clarification as to where to send his payment and for the remaining amount that he owes for his appeal filing fee. Plaintiff originally sent \$358.46 of his appeal filing fee to the Seventh Circuit Court of Appeals, which forwarded this payment to this court. To clarify, plaintiff is advised that the remaining amount he owes for the appeal filing fee in this case is \$96.54 ($\$455 - \$358.46 = \96.54). Plaintiff is further advised that appeal fee payments must be made to the district court where the case originated. That is, his \$96.54 appeal payment must be sent to *this* court's clerk's office. His check must be made out to Clerk, United States District Court and sent to Clerk's Office, 120 N. Henry Street, room 320, Madison, Wisconsin 53703.

Turning to plaintiff's request for extension of time to file the remainder of his appeal fee, plaintiff is advised that this is a matter only the court of appeals may entertain. I will deny the motion and forward it to the court of appeals.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff Glenn Turner's motion for extension of time to pay the remainder of the balance of the \$455 appeal filing fee,, dkt. #41, is DENIED. The motion will be forwarded to the court of appeals.
