AMENDED  
SCHEDULING ORDER

11-cr-37-wmc

At a September 6, 2011 telephonic status conference with counsel, after hearing from all parties, this court granted defendant Jeff Frost's motion to extend all dates in the schedule to allow adequate time to review the government's evidence, to prepare pretrial motions and to prepare for trial. *See* dkt. 20. I struck the existing schedule in favor of these dates:

Pretrial motions and discovery requests: noon, December 19, 2011.

Pretrial motion hearing and any evidentiary hearing: December 22, 2011 at 11:00 a.m.

Deadlines to disclose expert witnesses: To be Decided by the Parties

Submissions for the final pretrial conference: February 7, 2012.

Final pretrial conference: February 9, 2012 at 9:00 a.m.

Final hearing: February 21, 2012 at 3:00 p.m.

Jury selection and trial: February 27, 2012 at 9:00 a.m.

The predicted trial length is five days. Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7), time from August 29, 2011 (when Frost filed his motion) until the new trial date is excluded from the speedy trial clock. The ends of justice and the Sixth Amendment require that the defendants and their attorneys receive adequate time to review the government's disclosures, investigate this case and prepare for trial.
