ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

- (1) Plaintiff Epic Systems Corporation's motion to seal its complaint is GRANTED;
- (2) Plaintiff shall immediately filed a public version of its complaint from which the sensitive information is redacted; and,
- (3) Each and every defendant, both directly and through any and all of its principals, officers, employees and other agents, shall maintain the confidentiality of the complaint in this lawsuit and all information contained in it and shall not disclose the complaint, its contents or information contained in it to any person or entity other than licensed attorneys (and staff of these attorneys) whom a defendant consults regarding possible retention to defend against this lawsuit.
