SECOND AMENDED
SCHEDULING ORDER

At a July 31, 2012 unrecorded telephonic scheduling conference, new counsel for the defendant stated that, based on his recent conversations with his client, he needs at least 30 additional days adequately to prepare his defense for trial. The government does not oppose granting this continuance. Accordingly, the court rescheduled the remainder of this case as follows:

Submissions for the final pretrial conference: August September 25, 2012.

Final pretrial conference: September 28, 2012 at 9:00 a.m.

Final hearing: October 4, 2012 at 4:00 p.m.

Jury selection and trial: Tuesday, October 9, 2012 at 9:00 a.m.

The parties predict a two day trial. Time continues to be excluded from computation on the speedy trial clock until October 9, 2012 in order to allow defendant's new attorney adequate time to consult with his client, investigate this case and prepare for trial, taking into account due diligence.
