Defendant Rachel Kopp has filed a motion for a reduction in her sentence under 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2). She has asked for a reduction to the bottom of the reduced guideline range; the government does not oppose the reduction.

When defendant was first sentenced, she had been found to have a total offense level of 12, with a criminal history score of VI. Her sentence was 30 months, at the bottom of the guideline range of 30-37 months.

With the recent reduction in the sentencing guidelines, defendant's revised total offense level is now 10 and her amended guideline range is 24-30 months. I am persuaded that defendant's sentence be reduced to the bottom of the amended guideline range.

## **ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED that defendant Rachel Kopp's sentence, imposed on May 14, 2013,

is reduced to 24 months under 18 U.S.C.  $\S 3582(c)(2)$ .
