At the December 3, 2012 hearing on the government's motion to revoke defendant Ricky Simpson's pretrial release, the court denied the motion but modified Simpson's conditions of release as follows:

1) Defendant shall be on 24-hour curfew at his residence every day. Exceptions to this curfew are employment and drug treatment, with other exceptions provided at the discretion of pretrial services after an in-advance request from defendant.

2) Defendant shall undergo outpatient drug counseling and treatment as directed by pretrial services.

3) Defendant shall not operate heavy machinery at work, including, without limitation forklifts, pallet jacks and floor jacks. Defendant forthwith shall advise his current employer of this restriction.
