Defendant Rosella Collins has moved for a change in her sentence to make her federal sentence run concurrently with a state of Florida sentence she is serving. As I told defendant in an order entered on January 13, 2015 denying her motion for a reduction of her sentence, the court lacks authority to reduce her sentence once it has been entered, with certain limited exceptions that do not apply to defendant's case. Even if I did have the authority, however, I would deny her motion. Defendant's fraudulent conduct was extensive and of long duration. A consecutive sentence of 30 months was a moderate response to defendant's wrongdoing.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that defendant's motion for modification of her sentence is DENIED.
