ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1) The parties shall file exhibit lists on the court's form available on its website (<http://www.wiwd.uscourts.gov/forms>) by noon on Wednesday, January 8, 2014; objections to exhibits are due noon on Friday, January 10, 2014;
- 2) The parties shall file hard copies or electronic copies of all contested exhibits by 2:30 p.m. on Friday, January 10, 2014;
- 3) The parties shall file a list of portions of depositions or narratives, to be offered into evidence at trial, by page and line references for witnesses unavailable at trial by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, January 10, 2014; objections and counter designations or

narratives are due by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, January 13, 2014. (Extensive reading from depositions is strongly discouraged. Toward that end, the proponent of a deposition may -- though is not required to -- prepare a written narrative summary of some or all deposition transcripts the party intends to offer into evidence, with annotated page and line references in parenthesis after each sentence, in lieu of part or all of the narrative of questions and answers);

- 4) The parties shall file short, written narrative statements of the background and experience of each expert by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, January 10, 2014; objections due by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, January 13, 2014; and
- 5) The parties shall file any further challenges, additions or modifications to the revised liability jury instructions or special verdict (circulated via email), including legal briefing, by noon on Thursday, January 9, 2014, with responses due by noon on Friday, January 10, 2014; and
- 6) The court will continue the final pretrial conference by telephone on Friday, January 10, 2014, at 2:30 p.m. Plaintiff to initiate call to chambers at 608-264-5087.
