The parties have filed a stipulation for attorney fees under the Equal Access to Justice Act, 28 U.S.C. 2412, in the amount of \$7,300 in full satisfaction of any claim for fees and costs in this case.

Further, the parties agree that the award may be paid to plaintiff's counsel but may be offset to satisfy any pre-existing debt owed by plaintiff Geddes to the United States pursuant to <u>Astrue v. Ratliff</u>, 130 S.Ct. 2521 (2010).

After entry of this order, if counsel for the parties can verify that plaintiff owes no pre-existing debt subject to offset, defendant will direct that the award be made payable to plaintiff's counsel under the EAJA assignment signed by plaintiff and her counsel.

## ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff Sage Geddes, on behalf of Ann M. Geddes is awarded attorney fees and costs in the amount of \$7,300. This amount is to be made payable to plaintiff's attorney, Dana Duncan, contingent upon payment of money owed to the United States.
