In this civil action for patent infringement brought by plaintiffs Ultratec, Inc. and Captel, Inc., defendants Sorenson Communications, Inc. and CaptionCall, LLC filed a motion for summary judgment and with that motion they filed declarations, exhibits and other documents under seal. As required under this court's administrative order, they filed unsealed, redacted versions of many of these documents. Administrative Order 311, available at http://www.wiwd.uscourts.gov/sites/default/files/Admin_Order_311.pdf. However, defendants have not filed unsealed, redacted versions of exhibits no. 1-20, 22-46 and 48-51 attached to the declaration of Jessica Quon, dkt. #85. Defendants filed a notice, dkt. #108, explaining that they did not file redacted versions because plaintiffs produced these documents and defendants believe it would be inappropriate for them to make the redactions to another parties' documents.

Although defendants make a valid point, parties may not avoid the administrative

order by filing copies of another parties' documents. Rather, in that situation, the party filing the document should give the other party an opportunity to prepare a redacted version of the document *before* the first party files the sealed document. Because defendants do not suggest that they gave plaintiffs such an opportunity, I will allow plaintiffs to do so now. If neither side files unsealed, redacted versions of exhibits no. 1-20, 22-46 and 48-51 from docket no. 85 by the date provided in the order, the clerk of court will unseal these documents.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiffs Ultratec, Inc. and CapTel, Inc. or defendants Sorenson Communications, Inc. and CaptionCall, Inc. may have until May 19, 2014 to file unsealed, redacted copies of the documents filed as exhibits no. 1-20, 22-46 and 48-51 to docket no. 85. If the parties fail to file the documents by that date, the clerk of court is directed to unseal the documents.
