ORDER

Defendant John Glavin has filed a motion for my recusal, dkt. #54, and a request for a stay of his sentencing so that another judge can familiarize himself with defendant's case before taking over the sentencing duties. The motion and accompanying request will be denied.

Defendant asserts that my comments at his plea hearing indicate that I cannot be impartial in sentencing, but he has failed to support that suggestion with any evidence. He merely points to my comments about lawsuits he filed in this court that he says were "extra judicial" knowledge. The knowledge was not "extra-judicial"; it was gained in my capacity as a judge and it was relied on only to reinforce my decision that defendant was not a good candidate for pre-sentencing release.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that defendant John Glavin's motion for my recusal and for a stay of sentencing to allow another judge to prepare for sentencing is DENIED.
