ORDER

The parties have jointly stipulated to a remand of this case under sentence four of Section 205(g) of the Social Security Act. They have agreed that they want the Appeals Council to remand the matter to an administrative law judge for further proceedings, specifically, to undertake a new assessment of plaintiff's residual functional capacity, including her psychological and mental limitations, and then determine how her ability to maintain concentration, persistence and pace in the workplace is accounted for in that assessment. In addition, they want the administrative law judge to obtain supplemental vocational expert evidence at step four and, as necessary, at step five of the sequential evaluation process.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that this case is remanded under sentence four of § 205 of the

Social Security Act for further proceedings. The clerk of court is directed to close the case.
