Plaintiff Mary Rodemeier filed this case on June 19, 2015, seeking judicial review of a decision of the Commissioner of Social Security pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 405(g), as well as leave to proceed in forma pauperis. On June 23, 2015, this court entered an order denying her application for leave to proceed in forma pauperis and giving plaintiff until July 24, 2015 to submit the \$400 filing fee. On July 27, 2015, plaintiff was granted a 30-day extension of time until August 26, 2015 to submit the filing fee. The magistrate judge warned plaintiff that if she failed to submit the filing fee her complaint would be dismissed for her failure to prosecute this case. It is now September 14, 2015 and plaintiff has not submitted the filing fee or otherwise responded to the court's order. Accordingly, plaintiff's case will be dismissed.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that this case is DISMISSED without prejudice for plaintiff Mary Rodemeier's failure to prosecute it. The clerk of court is directed to administratively close this case.
