Effective November 1, 1988, all criminal fines and assessments shall be paid to the Clerk of this court. Effective February 1, 1989, all payments of restitution shall be paid to the Clerk of this court.

When funds are received from an individual who has more than one type of financial obligation to the government, the funds shall be credited first to any criminal assessment, second to any restitution, third to any fine, and fourth to any reimbursement of attorney fees.

Whenever restitution is ordered payable to multiple victims, the Clerk of Court shall follow any court order directing the order of payment to victims. The Chief Probation Officer or his designated probation officer is authorized to give the Clerk of Court written directions as to the order of payment to victims; a copy of such directions together with a written explanation of the reasons for the directed order of payments shall be provided to the sentencing judge and to the Collection Division of the United States Attorney's Office. written directions, the Clerk of Court shall pay the first regular restitution payment to the entity that has suffered the greatest loss, and subsequent regular payments to the other victims in decreasing order of the size of their losses, repeating the sequence after all victims have received a payment. The Clerk of Court shall obtain written directions from the Probation Officer or the sentencing judge before distributing irregular restitution payments.
