In Re: Temporary Closing of the Courthouse to the
Public

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 367

To limit the spread of coronavirus, the court orders that the courthouse will be closed to the general public from July 17 through July 24, 2020. The court will continue to monitor conditions in the community, and the closing may be extended if circumstances warrant.

All in-person proceedings during the closure will be rescheduled. Court operations will otherwise continue as scheduled, including proceedings by telephone or videoconference.

The building will be open to those with access credentials or escorted by those with credentials. Filings will continue to be processed in civil and criminal cases via the CM-ECF electronic system and by mail. Visitors may file documents by using the drop box in the courthouse lobby. Payments will be processed via credit card through the link on our website www.wiwd.uscourts.gov. Payments by check or money order will be accepted by mail or the courthouse drop boxes. Cash payments will not be accepted during this closure.
