ORDER

The Clerk of this Court is hereby authorized to dispose of the following jury records at any time after ten years after the close of the related term of court:


- a. Questionnaires, police reports, and other records relating to the determination of juror qualifications.
- b. Juror ballots and certified list of jurors drawn.
- c. Correspondence and related papers pertaining to the selection of juries and foremen, juror qualifications and service, and oaths of bailiffs, secretaries, and interpreters taken in writing.
- d. Petitions, motions and orders relating to the mechanics of jury selections, accommodation and discharge.
- e. Jury panels, and records of attendance and payment of jurors, jury commissioners and witnesses.
- f. Notices, praecipes, subpoenas, warrants, contempt attachments and other papers used in summoning and compelling attendance of jurors.

The Clerk of this Court is further authorized to transfer any of the above jury records to the appropriate

Federal Records Storage Center at any time after 5  
years after the close of the related term of court.
