WHEREAS, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 631 and the regulations promulgated by the Judicial Conference of the United States, by concurrence of a majority of the judges of the court, Anita M. Boor is to be appointed United States Magistrate Judge.

Therefore, in accordance with the authority conferred by 28 U.S.C. § 631, and the further authority granted and action taken by the Judicial Conference of the United States,


IT IS ORDERED that Anita M. Boor:

1. is hereby appointed as United States Magistrate, with her official duty station being designated at Madison, Wisconsin;
2. shall enter upon the performance of her duties as United States Magistrate at 12:01 a.m. on May 6, 2024, but prior to the commencement of such duties she shall take the oath or affirmation prescribed by 28 U.S.C. § 453 and 631(f); and
3. is to hold and discharge the duties of her office as United States Magistrate for a term of eight years from the date of her appointment subject to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 631(c), unless sooner removed.

The Clerk shall forward a certified copy of this order to the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Court as required by 28 U.S.C. § 631(1).


