ORDER 455

Consistent with historical practice, the court will be closed for certain days during the winter holidays.

IT IS ORDERED that the United States District Court for the Western District of Wisconsin, including the Bankruptcy Court and Probation Office for the Western District of Wisconsin, will close at noon on Wednesday, December 24, 2025. December 24 will not be considered a day when the Clerk's Office is inaccessible under Rule 6(a)(3) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, so deadlines set for December 24 will remain. The court will be closed on Thursday, December 25 and Friday, December 26, 2025. Any matter or deadline previously set for December 26, 2025, is continued to December 29, 2025, or another date set by the judge presiding in the matter.

In observance of the New Year holiday, the court will be closed on Thursday, January 1 and Friday, January 2, 2026. Any matter or deadline previously set for January 2, 2026, is continued to January 5, 2026, or another date set by the judge presiding in the matter.
