Entry of Default and Default Judgment

This court uses a two-step process for default and default judgment. First, the clerk enters default under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 55(a) when a party has failed to plead or otherwise defend. Second, the court enters default judgment under Rule 55(b) after a hearing. This packet contains examples of motions, affidavits, and other documents that are used in the process.

Step One

To move for entry of default, a party must electronically file:

- 1. a motion for entry of default,
- 2. an affidavit (or declaration) in support of the motion,
- 3. a proposed entry of default, and
- 4. a certificate of service.

Step Two

To obtain a default judgment, a party must electronically file:

- 1. a motion for default judgment,
- 2. an affidavit (or declaration) in support of the motion,
- 3. a proposed default judgment, and
- 4. a certificate of service.
